

## World Series of Membership

1. Jurisdictions are divided into 6 leagues of twelve each.
2. The month of July is the Qualifying Round. Even though each jurisdiction is playing against another jurisdiction, the top eight in the standing (based on percentage) advance to play for the first and second prizes, while the bottom four move to the bracket that compete for the third and fourth prizes.
3. The months of August, September and October are treated as double elimination brackets.
4. Standings are posted daily on the Supreme Website in the Officers Section under the Membership Incentive Tab: <http://www.kofc.org/un/eb/en/officers/index.html>.
5. There are added incentives to the World Series of Membership if a jurisdiction achieves ten percent (10%) of its intake goal in any month during the four-month period beginning in July, as follows:
  - a. Once in July, August, September or October the jurisdiction will earn \$100.00;
  - b. Twice in July, August, September or October the jurisdiction will earn \$200.00;
  - c. Thrice in July, August, September or October the jurisdiction will earn \$300.00; or
  - d. In each of the first four months (July, August, September or October) the jurisdiction will earn \$500.00
  - e. These payouts are guaranteed no matter where the jurisdiction stands in the World Series of Membership finals.
6. If a jurisdiction achieves fifty percent (50%) of its intake goal by December 31, 2010, the Supreme Council will contribute \$2000.00 to the jurisdiction's Christopher Fund.
7. There is also a District Deputy's contest. If there are ten new members in the district by September 30, 2010, the District Deputy will earn a toolbox. If there are 20 new members in the district by September 30, 2010, the District Deputy will also be awarded a mug and Thermos. Finally, if there are 30 new members in the district by September 30, 2010, he will also receive a camping chair.
